LORENTZ IVORRA



An artist who doesn't take themselves too seriously, quite off their head and with a strong character, Lorentz Ivorra is a vocal coach and singer dropping their **debut EP, X**, in April 2025.

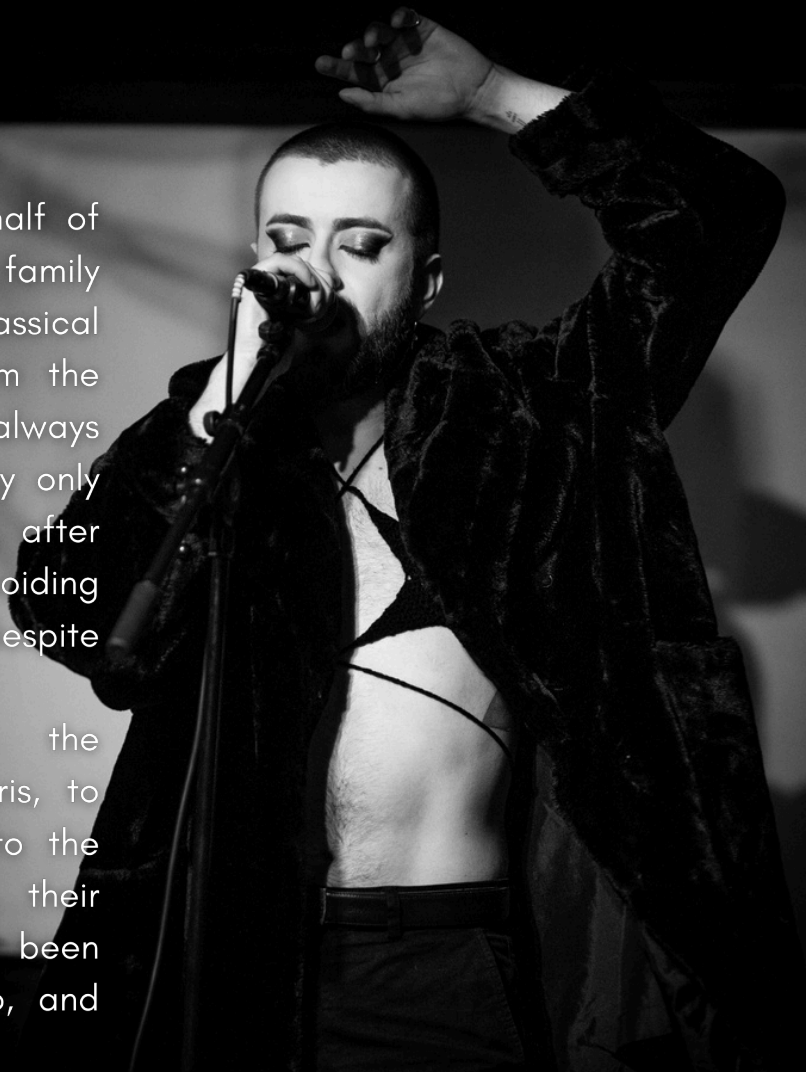
Following the release of their first three singles in 2024—***Blondie Kitty Kat***, ***Kiss Your Cheek***, and ***Lust***—tracks that set the tone for their vocal prowess, the distinct voice in their songwriting, and the diversity of their musical influences, they return in April 2025 to present ***X***, their very first EP.

With this new project, Lorentz channels their desire to show different sides of themselves and to use music as a release. They explore light-hearted themes like friendship and sexuality, alongside deeper, even painful ones such as grief, trauma, and their relationship with their body.

This EP sketches the outline of who they are as an artist—reflecting influences that range from pop, R&B, and soul, with poetic songwriting, to rock and hard rock, revelling in the extremes of voice, distorted and saturated sounds, and a grungier edge. It's a catharsis, reclaiming power over their body and identity, giving voice to their struggles and proudly flying the flag of their queer, non-normative identity.

Initially a dancer during the first half of their life, Lorentz Ivorra grew up in a family of opera singers, immersed in classical music, jazz, and French pop from the 1960s. A slightly rebellious child who always tried not to follow the crowd, they only turned to music at the age of 15, after years devoted solely to dance—avoiding their parents' profession and path, despite its strong appeal.

In 2013, they joined ATLA, the contemporary music school in Paris, to study singing. Deeply connected to the roots of African-American music, their artistic and vocal development has been shaped by soul, funk, blues, disco, and jazz.



It was only later that they began blending these influences with more recent movements such as grunge, hard rock, house, and pop, shaping themselves into a queer diva with gloriously chaotic inspirations.

They'll speak to you in both English and French in **X**, about their friendships, lovers, sex, politics, personal struggles, and their intersectional queer feminist values—using raw, sometimes sharp words, yet never without a certain tenderness, poorly hidden beneath that heap of verbs.

If Lorentz Ivorra were an album: *Lemonade* by Beyoncé.

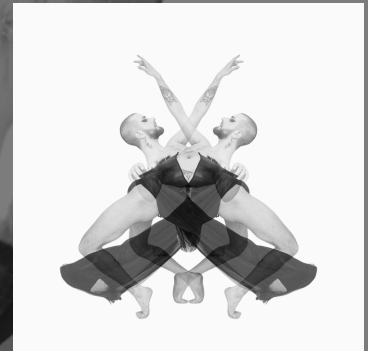

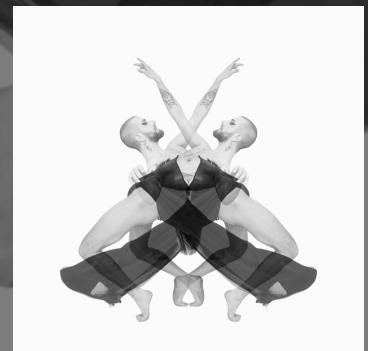
Comedy' Clown is a rap track – a first on an original song for Lorentz. It's without doubt the piece that acts as a catalyst for all their anger and their rage to break free from their chains – those of a society that wounds and oppresses the queer and trans community. A message of revolt, delivered with sharp lyrics, all set to heavy bass and a perfectly gritty rock guitar

VII is a lyrical a cappella interlude, conceived and written in dissonance – a transition steeped in the kind of singing that shaped their childhood. A rebirth that allows them to channel their anger into a deeper realisation of themselves



Mirror is a track Lorentz wrote in just an hour, after walking through Paris one June day wearing makeup – and being met with a torrent of insults. In that moment, a need surged within them to push back against the hatred rooted in ignorance and self-loathing. It's a love letter to the person they've become – someone who still walks tall through jeering crowds, and remains just as loud, just as vocal.

Le Lion is a love letter – both literal and metaphorical – addressed to a love that was never fulfilled, and to French poetry itself. A song as light as a summer fling... or maybe not. Set in an elsewhere-like atmosphere, and always underscored by the hum of electric guitar, Lorentz tells us a story.





DISCOGRAPHY 2024



Lust, an electrifying title that reinvents Lorentz's hard rock influences, is the latest single in the trilogy heralding the release of their EP in 2025. Through sounds blending distortion with powerful, saturated vocals, this song explores queer fantasy and sexuality with lyrics that oscillate between deceptively poetic metaphors and raw expressions.



Kiss Your Cheek is their new single and the second track of their EP. It is in a much more melancholic atmosphere and with a deep tone that Lorentz addresses separation, longing, and trauma, without ever fully confessing everything...



Blondie Kitty Kat, the lightest track of their project, is Lorentz Ivorra's first single and the first track they ever wrote. A story of a friendship with one of their queer sisters, this track mainly showcases their funk influences that have always made them dance.









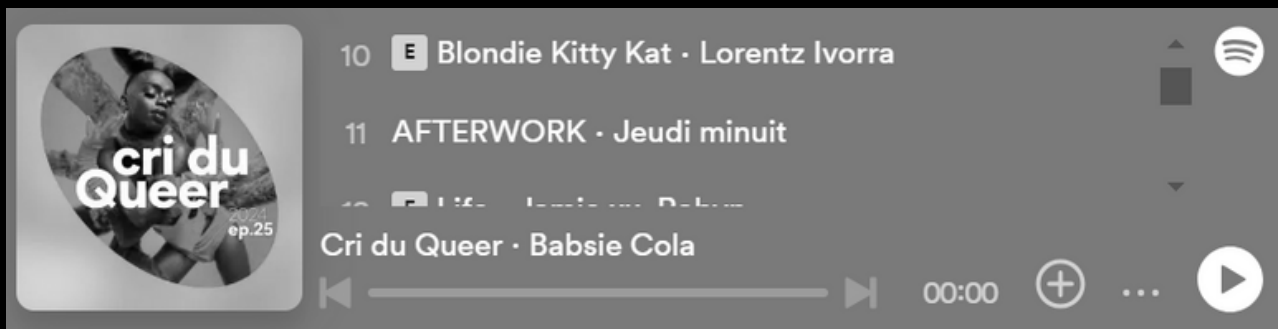
